


OSHA 10 General Training

Countless employees are being exposed to general industry hazards on a daily basis. To help workers stay safe and compliant, we have tapped subject matter experts to develop the **10-Hour General Industry Outreach Training Program**. This program is intended to provide an **entry level** general industry worker's broad awareness on recognizing and preventing hazards on a general industry site. Trainees will be introduced to OSHA policies, procedures and standards as well as general industry safety and health principles and work practices covered in OSHA Act Part 1910. *Special emphasis* will be placed on areas most hazardous using OSHA standards as a guide. General industry workers must receive additional training, when required by OSHA standards, on specific hazards of the job.

OSHA 10 Construction Training

Industry experts have created this 10-hour outreach training program with **entry-level construction workers** in mind. It underscores how to recognize, avoid, abate, and prevent occupational hazards in the construction industry. Aside from an orientation to construction-related safety and health issues at work, these training modules tackle OSHA regulations, employer responsibilities, and even workers rights.
